## Self Contained Host Farm Accommodation

A relaxed rural setting, accommodates up to 24 people. Great for families and groups of friends. "Wairere" was one of the first settlements south of the Delatite River, its original shearing shed dating back to 1860. Today, a 400ac. beef cattle property and working farm. Plenty of room for the kids to run and play.

Fifteen minutes drive from Mansfield, 30 minutes from Mt.Buller, Mt.Stirling and the Alpine National Park, 10 minutes from Gough's Bay, deep-water boat launching on Lake Eildon. And close by to 5 major rivers. There's plenty to do, fishing, boating, swimming, skiing, walking, trail bike riding and 4WDing to name a few. OR simply relax and enjoy the peaceful surroundings and the magnificent countryside.

Wairere Lodge is the first gate to your left. Come up the driveway and turn left at the first small shed. We look forward to welcoming you.
